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- Race time, Course, Code, Surface Conditions and Race Distance
- 2 Race Title, Class, Age Group, Prize Money and Number of Runners
- 3 Saddle Cloth, and (Draw)

- Latest Form for todays code (in brackets), down to 9<sup>th</sup> position, most recent right. Figures to the left of the "-" are last season, wins (1) are highlighted in blue
- Horse's name and country where the horses was not bred in the GB. Days Since Last Run,
  b=blinkers, v=visor, e/s=eyeshield, e/c=eyecover, h=hood, t=tongue strap, p=sheepskin cheek pieces
  1=1<sup>st</sup> 1st time headgear, BF=Beaten Favourite, C=Course Winner, D=Distance Winner
  CD=Course and Distance Winner.

E.g. O'Gorman – 37 days since last run, wears a hood for the first time and is a distance winner

Indicates whether a horse is well handicapped against its official rating (OR) in a handicap of the same race type. If todays OR is higher than horses highest winning OR (HiOR) the chart indicates **red**. If the horses HiOR Is below todays OR the chart indicates **green**. The figure to the right indicates the number of pounds the official rating is above or below HiOR.

- 10 Indicates how many positive Proform statistical factors and negative Proform statistical factors a horse has . E.g #9 The Tichborne has two negative factors
- Indicates in a race of the same race type whether a horses is dropping in class ↓, running in the same class ↔, or being raised In class ↑ compared to its recent race. Tariq Too is dropping in class in todays race
  - A faster than class indicator. The horses Proform last time out Speed Rating, compared to the Class Pars for winners at todays race type. The chart indicates how much the rating is above (green) or below (red) this median rating
- <sup>13</sup> The horses Proform statistical Rating with predicted betting forecast. The table is ordered by Proform Rating

Trainer/Jockey 5 Year Course Record. Exp – Expected Winners: statistically derived from the probability of the winners (W)

A/E – A ratio of (A)ctual winners verses (E)xpected winners. A/E provides a good indicator of whether a statistic is good or bad.

Each symbol represents ~ 10% - ■ = above ● = below ■ = > 100%

For example: in the trainer table David Evan's 5 year course record is approx. 40% below expected (2 winners verses 3.4 expected)

In the Jockey table. Silvestre De Sousa has a 5 year course record approx. 60% better than expected (15 winners verses 9.3 expected)

2 Trainer Name

Trainer Trend - using the results of all the trainers runners from the past 4 months, a graphical trend of the trainers A/E (Actual verses Expected) statistic is plotted over this time period. A black dot indicates the trainers highest A/E, a red dot Indicates the trainers lowest A/E.

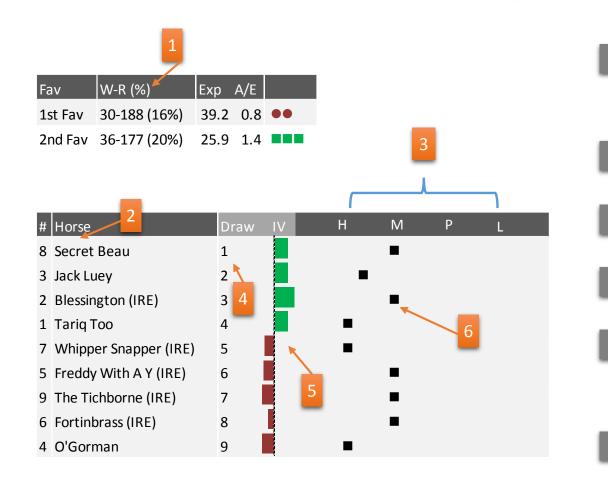
Trainers 14 day, 28 day and 56 day statistical record. (W)inners, (R)unners, Strike Rate (%)

Exp – Expected Winners: statistically derived from the probability of the winners A/E – Actual/Expected: a ratio of (A)ctual winners verses (E)xpected winners. Provides a good indication of whether a statistic is good or bad.

Each symbol represents ~ 10% -  $\blacksquare$  = above ● = below  $\blacksquare$  = > 100%For example, William Knights 28 day was 30% below expected, but his 14 day record Is 80% better than expected suggesting recent improvement in stable form

Similar to the method used in the Trainer/Jockey statistics tables , this table details the statistical performance of  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  favourites given the same race conditions. In the example,  $1^{st}$  favourites perform ~20% below expected  $2^{nd}$  favourites perform ~30% better than expected

Saddle Cloth and Horse Name

Pace Style – H=Held Up, M=Mid Field, P= Prominent, L=Led

Stall position (Flat racing only)

A graphic which uses the (I)mpact (V)alue Index statistic which compares one group of data against another with the same characteristic; in this case individual stall positions. With the statistic plotted visually, the draw bias for each stall can be taken into consideration when assessing the race.

Using the horses last three runs a statistical predication of the horses anticipated pace style in todays race is plotted on the grid to coincide with the styles defined in (3) above.

In conjunction with the data detailed in (3) and (6), the relevant statistics for each pace style is shown. Using this data, an assessment of how the race will be run i.e. "the pace of the race" can be derived.

# Suggested use of the Proform Racecard

### The comments below are provided for guidance only and should not be used as a selection method or system

- Using the "Proform Rating", note the higher rated and closely rated horses
- Using the horses form string determine which horses perform well given the conditions of todays race
- Make a note of horses that are dropping in class, who ran a Speed Rating faster than class in their last race and those that are well handicapped
- Allowing for the draw bias, visualise the running of the race. Determine which horses are suited to the draw/pace conditions.
- Review horse's stable form and jockey form to determine if either are suffering from below par performances
- Think chances! From the list of your contenders and using the Proform Racecard betting forecast, determine which horses are underestimated in the market based on your assessment of the race.
- Use the racecard to augment your own handicapping factors, systems or process
- The information in the racecard can also be used to provide a quick snapshot of the race. If required use formbooks such as **Proform Professional** to analyse the race in more detail
